









## **What You Need:**

- materials that might be good insulators (packaging wrap, cotton balls, straw, towels, paper, old T-shirt, etc.)
- ice cubes
- · containers or boxes with lids

## **Instructions:**

- 1. Layer the insulating material in one container.
- 2. Put some ice cubes in your container and close the lid.
- 3. Choose another insulating material and repeat with another container.
- 4. Put the containers in an area away from direct sunlight or heat.
- 5. Check on the ice cubes to see which ones melt guicker.
- 6. Try different insulating materials to see which work best!
