











## **What You Need:**

- any containers (ex. pie tins, cake pans, plastic containers)
- natural objects (ex. berries, leaves, twigs)
- water
- string
- food coloring (optional)

## **Instructions:**

- 1. Arrange the natural objects in the container.
- 2. Pour water into the container. Add a few drops of food coloring if you wish.
- 3. Lay the center of the string into the water.
- 4. Place in the freezer until frozen.
- 5. Remove the suncatcher from the container and hang outdoors in a sunny spot. Depending on temperatures, they will slowly melt over the winter.

## Tip:

Use only natural supplies that will naturally decompose over time.
