

What You Need:

- balloons
- water
- food coloring (optional)
- scissors



Instructions:

- 1. Fill balloons with water and add a few drops of food coloring if you wish.
- 2. Tie off the ends of the balloons.
- 3. If temperatures are below zero at night, put the balloons outside overnight. Otherwise, balloons may be placed in the freezer until they are frozen.
- 4. Once the balloons are frozen, use scissors to cut the ends of the balloons. Try to do this outside as this could be messy.
- 5. Peel the balloons off the frozen globes.
- 6. Place frozen ice globes outside along walkways or wherever you wish!





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
