

## OUR WIND SOCK

## **Materials Included:**

- Construction paper
- Ribbon
- Stickers

## **Materials Needed:**

- Stapler
- Scissors
- Markers
- Other craft supplies
- Hole punch (optional)

## **Instructions:**

- 1. Decorate your paper with the stickers and whatever craft supplies you have at home.
- 2. Roll the paper into a cylinder shape tube and staple the tube together.
- 3. Cut the ribbon into various lengths, saving about 6 inches for later.
- 4. Staple the ribbon to the bottom of tube. \*If you have a hole punch at home, you can punch holes and tie the ribbon to the bottom instead of stapling.
- 5. Take the 6-inch ribbon and staple each end to the top of the tube. This is how it will hang. \*If you have a hole punch, punch 2 holes at the top of your wind sock and tie each end to the holes at the top instead of stapling.
- 6. Hang your wind sock outside and watch the ribbons dance in the breeze.
